

## Monogrammed Pillow



### Supplies:

- 2- 12x12 scraps
- 8x10 scrap
- Wonder Under
- 13x13 piece of batting
- Fiber Fill
- Mirror image Letter (about 4x6)

1. The easiest way to get a letter is to use your favorite word processing program and print a letter with the font size 400-500 and reverse the image. Either your printer or your word process should be able to handle the mirror image.
2. Trace the letter onto the paper side of the wonder under. (Do NOT cut out!)
3. Iron your letter onto the wrong side of your 8x10 scrap. Cut out the letter. Peel off the backing.
4. Iron your letter right side up onto one piece of 12x12 fabric.
5. Lay your 12x12 piece of fabric (with letter ironed



on) right side up on top of your batting.

6. Stitch around the edge of your letter. Continue stitching outside the letter, around and around until the whole top is quilted. Trim batting from edges.

7. Lay your backing piece on top of your letter piece, right sides together. Pin around the edges, marking where the hole will be for turning.
8. Sew 1/2" around the edges leaving a



- hole. Clip corners and turn right side out.
9. Stuff with fiber fill. Hand stitch opening closed.
